RED FLAG COMMENTS

> "We always have puppies available"

The breeder won't care if you have toddlers or other pets, or how you plan to raise and train the puppy.

"Here are the numbers of a couple of happy customers."

"I use to be involved but it was just taking up too much time."

"My dogs are healthy, no need to test them."

BREEDER

The **breeder will interview you**. He has a strong interest in placing his puppy in the very best home possible.

REFERENCES

Will give you names and contact details of other responsible breeders for reference, and not just puppy buyer references.

INDUSTRY

A responsible breeder is involved in canine activities such as agility, obedience sport, conformation, kennel club memberships, rescue and so on. And they are proud of the titles their dogs have won.

HEALTH TESTING A responsible breeder will have dogs in their breeding program **tested for various know issues (OFA, genetic, etc.)** and then not breed that dog if it has issues.
